People seeking recovery in Washington know how to connect and get support at Clubhouse.




People with mental health conditions have meaningful opportunities for housing and employment.

While HERO House NW is not an employment or housing provider, we recognize their critical importance in recovery, and are committed to increasing access to both in ways that align with our mission, values, and model.





OUR INITIATIVES

STRENGTHENING THE CLUBHOUSE FOUNDATION (INTERNAL)

Sustainability: HHNW is financially sustainable.

Standards and quality: HHNW provides guidance and infrastructure that enables Clubhouses to maintain consistency across programs while remaining flexible for needs specific to their communities.

Accreditation: HHNW ensures fidelity to the 37 standards set forth by Clubhouse International.

BY 2024:

- HHNW has developed guidelines and budgets for what it costs to start up a Clubhouse and sustain it over time.
- HHNW has created a Program Director network across the state.
- WA State legislature has allocated \$16 million in permanent funding for Clubhouses across the state.
- HHNW has increased individual gifts and foundation giving to 40% of the overall organizational budget.
- All 3 HHNW Clubhouses are accredited.

OUR INITIATIVES

BUILDING THE CLUBHOUSE NAME AND MODEL (EXTERNAL)

Creating a National Brand and Affiliate

Model: We build the Clubhouse model to meet the needs of 2021 and the future (through partnership with Fountain House and other nationally recognized Clubhouse organizations).

Awareness: Everyone knows what Clubhouse is when they're looking for recovery, and HHNW is a recognized brand across the state.

Data: We'll build the knowledge base of Clubhouses, cross-sharing metrics throughout our network to add to current research and findings that support the effectiveness of the Clubhouse model.

BY 2024:

- An affiliate model that allows for high quality standards paired with responsiveness to local community needs has been developed.
- HHNW has executed a comprehensive marketing and communications plan creating brand recognition in Washington State.
- Serve as a primary technical assistance resource to other Clubhouses seeking accreditation in Washington State.



OUR INITIATIVES

CREATING PARTNERSHIPS THAT AMPLIFY OUR IMPACT

Housing: People in behavioral health recovery have healthy, safe, and affordable housing options available to them, in alignment with the Clubhouse International housing standards.

Employment: People in behavioral health recovery have a network of employers with jobs that meet members' needs through independent, supported and transitional employment.

Equity: HHNW represents the community we serve and builds relationships with communities that aren't in the room.

Behavioral Health: HHNW has a clear referral process and deep partnerships with referring behavioral health organizations, connecting more people to Clubhouse.

BY 2024:

- HHNW has 5 official partnerships that help grow our referral process, housing, employment and other opportunities for people with mental illness.
- Across our 3 Clubhouse locations, 50% of members secure supported employment through one of the employment programs.
- Across our 3 Clubhouse locations, increasing housing for members by 25%.
- Clubhouse membership and staffing adequately represents the diversity of Washington State aligning with most recent US Census data.
- HHNW has metrics about how members are referred to accredited Clubhouses in Washington.
